The National Agricultural Marketing Council (NAMC) has noted with concern the unauthorised and deceptive usage of its logo as well as widely publicised fake partnership by the organisation that identifies itself as Tiger Agriculture and Multi-Purpose

Co-operative Limited.

Tiger Agriculture has used NAMC logo to promote its activities without our permission, inducing unsuspecting and gullible members of the public and our stakeholders to attend

their events.

We therefore would like to state categorically that we do not have any form of relationship

partnership with Tiger Agriculture. Furthermore, we are distancing ourselves from

Tiger Agriculture's activities and accordingly warn members of the public and our

stakeholders to exercise caution when they come across such typical posters or

invitations.

We regard this unscrupulous behaviour by Tiger Agriculture as an effort to undermine the

integrity and good reputation that the NAMC has built over the years with its stakeholders

and the public.
